- He would be a light to the Gentiles. Is. 49:6
- His hands and feet would be pierced. Ps. 22:16
- His clothing would be dispersed by casting lots. Ps. 22:18
- He would die with unrighteous men. Is. 53:9, 12
- A rich man would attend to his death. Is. 53:9
- He would be betrayed by a close friend. Ps. 41:9
- He would die for the sins of the people. Is. 53:5-6, 8, 10-12
