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Hamilton Christian School Dual Enrollment Policies for Home School Students

1. Students may take classes a la carte at HCS at the scheduled time with students at the school at a prorated cost of \$650 per course.
2. Registration is based upon available class spots.
3. Course fees include books, materials, and student insurance.
4. Students are asked to wear khaki pants and either an HCS uniform shirt or a plain white, hunter green, or black uniform style shirt. Friday dress is blue jeans (no holes) and a school (HCS or Home School) issue t-shirt.
5. HCS can send a transcript upon request but students taking courses a la carte will not be considered for participation in HCS graduation exercises.
6. The Louisiana High School Athletic Association permits home school students to play on conventional school teams if that student lives within the district of the school. If interested, we can answer questions regarding athletics.
7. Lunches are available for \$3.50 each. A student may pre-order a month at a time or inquire of availability of meals for purchase on individual days.
8. Home school students will be expected to abide by the rules of HCS and the class. Discipline problems may result in removal

9. A class must have a minimum of students enrolled to be scheduled. High school courses offered for 2018-19:

English (I, II, III, IV) Term papers required for English III & IV
Math (Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Algebra III, Advanced Math, Pre-Calculus, Calculus)
Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physical Science, Biology II, Environmental Science, Physics)
Social Studies (U.S. History, Civics, World History and World Geography)
Art (Art I, Fine Arts Survey, Photography I)
Spanish (I, II, III, IV)
Religion (I, II, III, IV)
Health and Physical Education (I, II, III)
Electives (Consumer and Family Science, Speech I, Intro to Basic Computer Applications).
