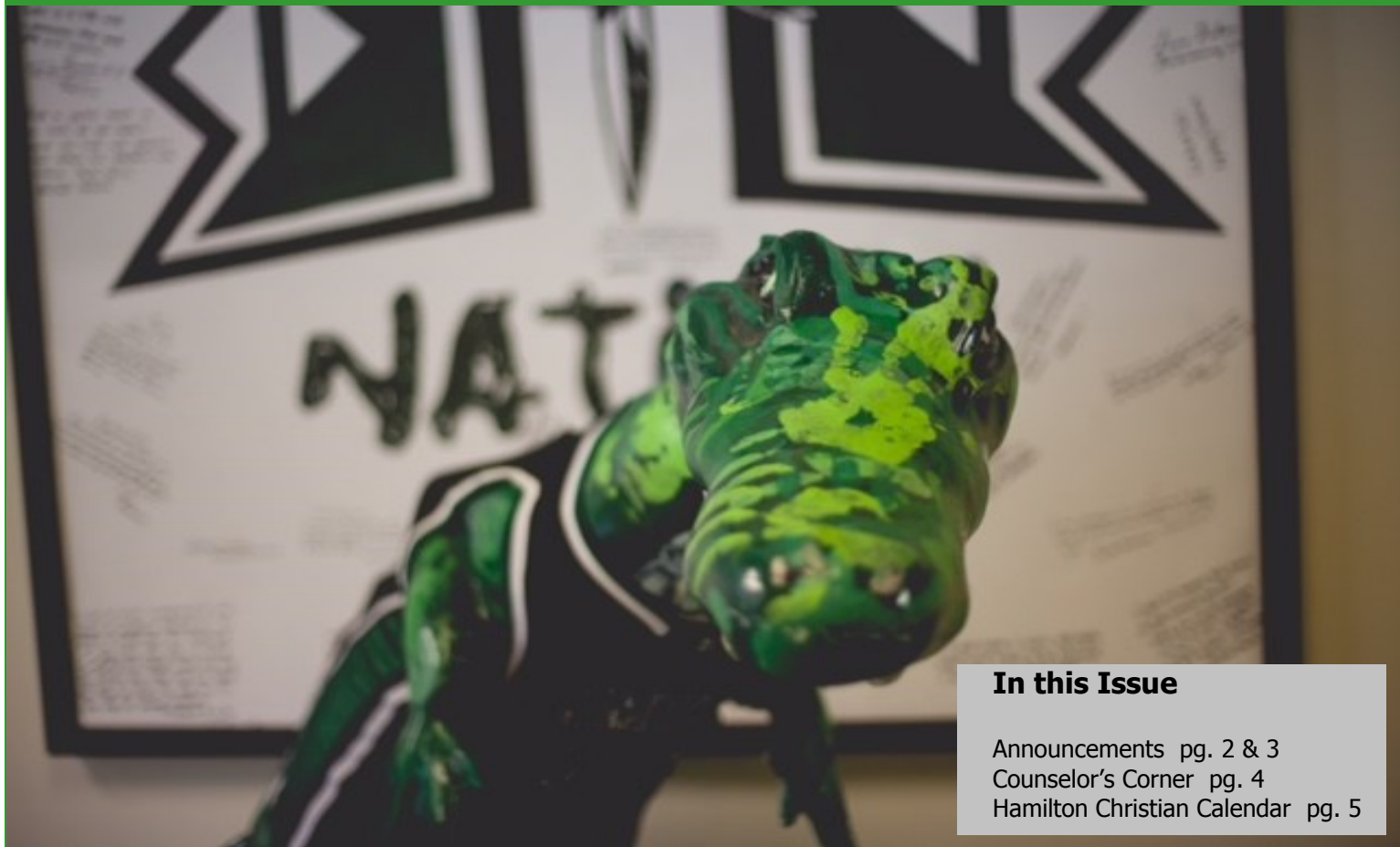

From Dr. McEntire

But we prayed to our God and posted a guard day and night to meet this threat. Nehemiah 4:9

With the recent school shooting in Florida (one of 18 school shootings just thus far in 2018), we must ask ourselves if we are prepared for the worst. First, let us keep a perspective. Even 18 incidences are out of tens of thousands of schools. The horror stories make the news rather than the millions of kids who have never seen violence in their schools. Secondly, we are mindful of the need to protect our precious cargo during school hours. We have a closed campus with limited access to outsiders. In my 15 years of being affiliated with the school, I only recall a couple of vagrants asking for money in the parking lot - never has anyone of questionable character entered the building. We do "Danger in the Building" drills and teachers know to ask anyone without a visitor's badge of the nature of their business.

Still, we live in a dangerous world and a person intent on inflicting harm often can and will find a way. We do what we know to do. In Nehemiah's day, he "posted a guard." But we, more than anything, we pray. God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in the time of trouble. I will not fear. I hope your heart is at rest as well.

How it works:

3. The school with the highest student attendance will be contacted, so that a date and time can be arranged for Mayor Hunter or his representative to visit the school to present the award.
4. Facebook Live, social media and/or press (American Press and KPLC) will be utilized to promote the winning school's receipt of the award. The next Teen Connection session is scheduled for **Thursday, March 1**.
