## Fall 2019/2020

Current families, to access your re-enrollment packet, you will use your **current username** and password to login **into Parent's Web**. Once you login, you will scroll down to **Apply/Enroll** then **Enrollment/Reenrollment**. You will see your student's packet-Click on **Start Enrollment Packet**.

Re-enrollment registration for (current students only) grades 1-12 is **\$150 per family if paid by January 31, 2019 Eastern Standard Time**. The cost for registration will go up to \$250 on February 1. On April 1, registration will be \$350 and then \$400 per family beginning July 1. Registration for families with only Pre-K 3, 4, and Kindergarten students is \$100 per family.

## Tuition Credit Plan

Any current HCS family may receive a \$200.00 credit to their fees by enlisting a new family to enroll in the school.

1. One \$200.00 credit per new family.
2. Credit will be applied during the first semester after both families have paid four monthly payments.
3. During the second semester (Jan.) the credit will be \$100.00 after both families have paid four monthly payments.
4. Both the current and new families must sign the Tuition Credit Form, found online.
