## From Dr. McEntire

As you make your plans for next year, remember that registration goes up \$100 on April 1. HCS is one of the most affordable options for private schooling in our area. Some may be interested to know about a few tuition discounts that are offered:

### TUITION DISCOUNTS

1. Employees of the school receive up to a fifty percent discount in tuition for children and grandchildren depending upon full-time or part-time status.
2. A few positions, such as cafeteria workers and classroom aides, can be filled in exchange for tuition and fees. Time requirement for full exchange is four hours per day or twenty hours per week.
3. Churches that support the school with at least \$5,000 per year are eligible for a fifty percent discount for children of their pastors and paid staff members.
4. Graduates of Hamilton are eligible for a five percent discount of tuition.
5. There is a five percent discount on tuition if full payment is made by May 24, 2019.
6. Second and third children receive a \$200 discount in tuition.
7. The maximum family liability for tuition is three students. Children must live in the same household and/or be claimed on the same tax return.

Also, if you refer a family who follows through with enrollment and attendance at HCS, you can receive a \$200 tuition credit. See the Handbook for full details.

## Silent Auction

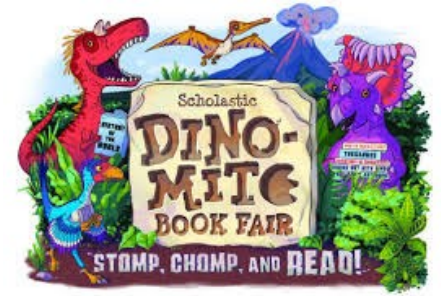

Qualifications for these openings according to the Bylaws are as follows:

1. Be a parent of student(s) enrolled at the school.
2. First have a commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ; then a commitment of loyalty and support to each other. Loyalty and support to the administration and staff will naturally follow.
3. Be a person of faith, service, prayer, and commitment.
4. Be a member of a local church and be active in that church.
5. Attempt to resolve problems that arise in school board business or in board administration relationships initially through prayer.
6. Be in agreement with the statement of faith as listed in the school handbook.

To be eligible, students must be a U.S. citizen and have a GPA of at least 3.0/4.0.
